LIVE PLANT LICENSE EXEMPTION

The Rules of the Georgia Department of Agriculture require any person or business selling live plants to obtain a Live Plant License from the Georgia Department of Agriculture [Rule 40-4-9-.02 (l)].

Furthermore, the sale of any live plants by any person or business that does not possess a Live Plant License is considered to be an unlawful act [Rule 40-4-9-.11 (g)].

However, certain businesses may be exempt from the licensing requirement. Businesses that are exempt from the Live Plant Licensing requirement include those that:

- Sell only cut flowers,
- Sell only cut Christmas trees, or
- Offer only services (i.e. landscape maintenance activities, including mowing, edging, fertilize application, etc.)

The above named business **DOES NOT** sell live plants or purchase live plants for landscape installation.
